

PRIVACY NOTICE

This Privacy Notice explains how your personal information will be collected, used and shared in connection with your application for the Programme. It should be read together with Goat Originals (Pty) Ltd's general Privacy Policy, available at <https://www.thegoat.africa/privacy>. Where this Privacy Notice deals specifically with the Programme, it supplements Goat Originals' general Privacy Policy.

1. The Producing Parties will use your personal information for the purposes of assessing your application for this series of the Programme, for future series where appropriate, and, if you are selected, for agreed publicity, production and related services.
2. Your personal information will only be shared where necessary for the purposes described in this notice, where required by law, or with trusted service providers engaged in the casting, production and distribution of the Programme.
3. The information will be kept securely by Goat Originals (Pty) Ltd in accordance with our internal policies and the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act No. 4 of 2013) ("POPIA"). Your information will generally be retained for up to 18 months after the close of the casting process to facilitate casting for future series, resolve any queries arising from your application and comply with legal or contractual obligations, after which it will be securely deleted or anonymised unless a longer retention period is required by law.
4. Personal information which you supply to Goat Originals during the application, auditions and casting process will be used in a number of ways, for example:
 - to assess whether you are a suitable contributor in relation to the Programme
 - in selecting potential contributors for the Programme
 - to develop, produce and publicise the Programmes and
 - (if you are selected to participate in the Programme) to broadcast and distribute the Programme and exploit all allied and ancillary rights including but not limited to video, DVD, online, books and magazines.
5. We will not knowingly publish your residential address, telephone number, email address or other personal contact details unless required by law or with your prior consent.
6. Where you provide personal information relating to another individual (for example, your partner), you confirm that you are authorised to provide that information and have informed them that their personal information is being submitted as part of this application.
7. Audition photographs, self-tapes, interviews and other audiovisual material submitted as part of your application will be used solely for casting and production purposes and will only be viewed by authorised persons involved in the casting process unless you are selected to participate in the Programme or have otherwise agreed to further use.

8. If you are shortlisted or selected, you may be asked to provide special personal information, including information relating to your health or criminal history, where this is reasonably necessary to assess your suitability to participate in the Programme and to fulfil our duty of care and health and safety obligations. We will ensure that access to such information is restricted to only members of the production team who will reasonably need to access it. We will securely destroy such information when it is no longer needed for these purposes.

9. If you are not selected, your application will remain confidential and will not be made public. Your information will continue to be handled in accordance with this notice and will only be accessed by authorised persons involved in the casting process or where disclosure is required by law.

10. If you are selected your information will be used for pre-agreed publicity purposes and related services.

11. By submitting this application, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Privacy Notice and, where required by law, consent to the processing of your personal information as described herein.

12. Subject to POPIA, you may request access to your personal information, request correction of inaccurate information, object to certain processing, or request deletion of information where appropriate. Requests should be sent to castings@thegoat.africa. We will consider and respond to such requests in accordance with POPIA.

13. Your personal information will not be used for any other direct commercial purposes including direct marketing.

14. If you are shortlisted or selected to proceed, you consent to appropriate identity verification, background screening and criminal record checks where reasonably necessary for the purposes of casting, production, participant welfare or insurance.

15. Your personal information may be transferred to, stored or processed in countries outside South Africa where this is necessary for the casting, production, broadcast or distribution of the Programme. We will take reasonable steps to ensure that your information receives an appropriate level of protection consistent with POPIA.

16. Submitting an application does not guarantee selection or production of the Programme. The Producing Parties reserve the right to amend, postpone, suspend or cancel the casting process or the Programme at any time.

17. Goat Originals (Pty) Ltd is the Responsible Party for the personal information collected through this application. Any questions relating to this notice or your personal information may be directed to our Information Officer at info@thegoat.africa.
